
Dear Chairman Stein and Members of the Siting Council:

At the pre-hearing conference conducted on August 21, 2012, the question arose as to how the Council members and its staff may inspect the area for the proposed tower and compound at Candidate A because no access road exists from Route 67 to the Candidate A tower site, and the terrain between Route 67 and the site is steep and wooded and requires a stream-crossing. After conferring with my clients, they have agreed to permit the Council and its staff to access Candidate A tower site from Bronson Mountain Road, which is a private road owned by my clients.

It is respectfully requested, however, that (1) the Council specifically require the Applicant to flag the entire 1,510' length and 30' width of the proposed access road and utility easement from Route 67 to the proposed tower site, and (2) at least some members of the Council or its staff hike the length of the proposed road. We have requested in our First Set of Interrogatories that the Applicant flag the access road, but we do not have any assurance that it will do so. Flagging or otherwise indentifying the location of the entire proposed 1,510' access drive is necessary so that the Council and its staff may adequately evaluate the environmental impact of the road and its construction, particularly the large number of trees that will need to be removed.

I would be happy to coordinate the details of the access from Bronson Mountain with your staff, and I appreciate your consideration of our requests.
