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NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after June 8, 2012 by New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility ("Facility") in Roxbury, Connecticut. The Facility is being proposed to allow AT&T to provide service in and around the Towns of Roxbury and Southbury. The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed Facility. Two (2) candidate locations are being considered; however only one (1) location is needed and only one (1) Facility will be constructed.

Candidate A is located on a parcel off of Route 67 in an area south of Highmeadow Lane and north of Bronson Mountain Road and identified by the Town of Roxbury Tax Assessor as Parcel Identification Number 32-008. This site would host a 170' monopole and associated unmanned equipment in a 75' x 75' fenced compound in the south central portion of the parcel. Vehicular access to the facility will be provided from Route 67 and over a 12' wide gravel access drive to the proposed compound. Utilities to serve the proposed facility would extend underground from a new on-site utility pole to the proposed Facility.

Candidate B is located at 126 Transylvania Road (Tax Assessor Parcel Identification Number 34-029) and would host a 170' monopole and associated unmanned equipment in a 75'x 75' fenced compound in the central north portion of the parcel. Vehicular access to the facility will be provided from Transylvania Road first over a portion of an existing driveway, then over a new 12' wide gravel access drive. Utilities to serve the proposed facility would extend underground from an existing offsite utility pole to the proposed facility.

For either candidate, AT&T would mount up to twelve (12) panel antennas on a low profile platform at a centerline height of 167' above grade level. A 12' x 20' equipment shelter will be installed adjacent to the tower within the fenced compound. The Facility will be available for co-location by other wireless carriers. The final location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

Balloons, raised to 170' above grade level (AGL) and representative of the proposed Facility height, will be flown at both proposed candidate sites on the first day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in Town, or on such other date specified by the Siting

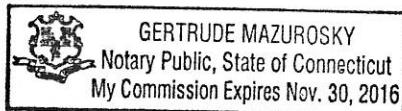
