The Department of Transportation (DOT) has reviewed the above-mentioned docket and offers the following comment.

Candidate "A"

The proposed project may result in a curb cut, Paving, tree/brush cutting, and underground utility work on State route 74 within the state right of way, therefore New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (A.T.&T.) must attain a Highway Encroachment Permit in conjunction with the Connecticut General Statues prior to performing any work within the right of way. The District 1 Permit Office will need review four complete sets of construction plans which show all work within the State highway right of way, all site work, any required easements and standard details for highway construction prior to issuing the encroachment permit.

The District 1 Permit Office will determine the bond amount, insurance coverage, maintenance and protection of traffic, inspection, roadway restoration and pavement restoration requirements. Please see attached D.O.T. Screening Check List.
