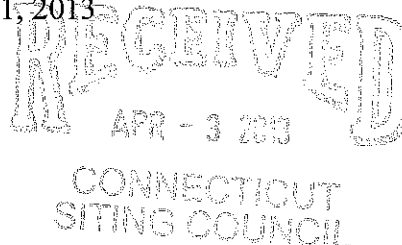

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

Dear Ms. Kelsey:

The State Historic Preservation Office is in receipt of the submitted proposal for the above-referenced project, submitted for review and comment pursuant to the National Historic Preservation Act and in accordance with Federal Communications Commission regulations.

Based on the information submitted and a field review of the project site, the proposed facility may be partially visible from the Whitman House and the Steele Allyn House, both individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places. However, it is unlikely that this proposed installation would adversely affect these resources. In addition, it is unlikely that any intact below-grade historic resources will be affected as there has already been extensive ground disturbance. Therefore, it is the opinion of this office that the proposed stealthed bell tower will have no adverse effect on the state's historic resources on the following conditions:

1. the tower will be stealthed, as shown in the submission and
2. if not in use for six consecutive months, the antennae and equipment shall be removed by the telecommunications facility owner. This removal shall occur within 90 days of the end of such six-month period. Upon removal, the property shall be restored by the facility owner to its historically appropriate appearance and materials.

The State Historic Preservation Office appreciates the opportunity to review and comment upon this project. These comments are provided in accordance with the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act and Section 106 of the National Historic
