DOCKET NO. 436 – Message Center Management, Inc. Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 465 Hills Street, East Hartford, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Laub:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated November 10, 2015 regarding the revision to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced site that was approved by the Council on October 17, 2013. Your request to install the backup generator and equipment shelter on a common concrete pad in the northeast corner of the fenced compound as a space-saving measure at the site is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision dated November 10, 2015. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-77.

The Council is also in receipt of the request for an extension of construction time in this docket dated November 10, 2015. Pursuant to Condition No. 8 of the Certificate dated July 25, 2013, I have considered your request for an extension of construction time in this docket and grant an extension of time until December 31, 2016 to complete the construction of this facility.

Pursuant to Condition Nos. 8 and 9 of the Certificate, any request for an extension to fully construct this telecommunications facility with at least one fully operational wireless telecommunications carrier shall be filed with the Council not later than 60 days prior to the expiration of this Certificate and shall be served on all parties and intervenors, as listed on the current service list and the Town of East Hartford.

This extension is granted with the understanding that the Council will be notified should the Certificate Holder decide not to proceed with construction.
