On behalf of Message Center Management, Inc. (MCM) and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T), please accept this letter regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to MCM in Docket 439 (Certificate).

Condition 7 of the Decision and Order dated October 31, 2013 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council's Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order. Upon our request the Siting Council previously granted extension of this time period to December 31, 2015.

Construction of the tower is complete and AT&T is finalizing installation of data service connection to the tower site with Frontier. While we anticipate the tower will be operational shortly, the end of the year is fast approaching and as a precautionary measure we respectfully request an extension of the Certificate's allowed completion time to March 31, 2016.
