NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(c) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after September 16, 2013 by Homeland Towers, LLC ("Homeland") and New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T") (together the "Applicants") for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility in Washington, Connecticut.

The proposed tower facility consists of a new self-supporting monopine tower and a 65' by 67' tower compound in the north-central portion of Town-owned property located at 10 Blackville Road in Washington Depot and generally known as the Town Garage site.

The Applicants propose a 135' AGL self-supporting monopine tower with aesthetic features resembling an evergreen tree. AT&T would install up to twelve (12) panel antennas and equipment at centerline height of approximately 126' AGL on the tower. An associated 12'x20' equipment shelter would be installed at the tower base together with a back-up power generator in the compound. The compound and tower will include space for other carriers as well as emergency communications equipment and be enclosed by an eight (8) foot tall chain link fence. Vehicle access to the facility would extend from Blackville Road along an existing access drive for approximately 1455' to the tower compound with a small extension of approximately 23'. Utility connections would be run underground from an off-site utility pole on Blackville Road.

The location, height and other features of the proposed Candidate Facilities are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

A facility is proposed to allow AT&T to provide service in Washington Depot and this area of the State. The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the proposed Facility and also describes the environmental effects of the Facility.

A Balloon, representative of the proposed height of the tower, will be flown at the site on the first day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in Town, or such other date specified by the Siting Council and a time to be determined by the Siting Council, but anticipated to be between the hours of 12 p.m. and 5 p.m.

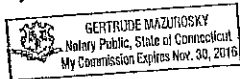
