Directions to Washington Municipal Garage at 10 Blackville Road

From Hartford, New Britain, Enfield, and Meriden.:

- Take I-84 westbound to Exit 15 in Southbury (Routes 6 and 67 – Southbury).
- At end of exit ramp, turn right to follow Route 6 East and Route 67 North.
- Follow Route 6 to Route 47 in Woodbury; turn left onto Route 47 North at intersection with traffic light and white church with tall steeple (approximately 5.3 miles)
- Follow Route 47 to center of Washington Depot in Washington; Turn right onto Bee Brook Road (Route 47 will turn right, which will also be Route 109 East).
- After approximately one quarter mile, turn right onto Blackville Road (Route 109 East)
- Municipal garage will be approximately 200 yards on left on Blackville Road.
- At the garage property, proceed to the top of the hill.

From Milford

- Take Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) westbound to Route 25 junction in Trumbull and follow Route 25 north to Newtown; in Newtown, get on I-84 eastbound and follow to Exit 15 in Southbury (Routes 6 and 67 – Southbury).
- At end of exit ramp, turn left to follow Route 6 East and Route 67 North.
- Follow Route 6 to Route 47 in Woodbury; turn left onto Route 47 North at intersection with traffic light and white church with tall steeple (approximately 5.3 miles)
- Follow Route 47 to center of Washington Depot in Washington; Turn right onto Bee Brook Road (Route 47 will turn right, which will also be Route 109 East).
- After approximately one quarter mile, turn right onto Blackville Road (Route 109 East)
- Municipal garage will be approximately 200 yards on left on Blackville Road.
- At the garage property, proceed to the top of the hill.

From Stamford

- Take Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) or I-95 eastbound to Route 7 junction in Norwalk and follow Route 7 north to I-84 in Danbury and get on I-84 to travel eastbound to Exit 15 in Southbury (Routes 6 and 67 – Southbury).
- At end of exit ramp, turn left to follow Route 6 East and Route 67 North.
- Follow Route 6 to Route 47 in Woodbury; turn left onto Route 47 North at intersection with traffic light and white church with tall steeple (approximately 5.3 miles)
- Follow Route 47 to center of Washington Depot in Washington; Turn right onto Bee Brook Road (Route 47 will turn right, which will also be Route 109 East).
- After approximately one quarter mile, turn right onto Blackville Road (Route 109 East)
- Municipal garage will be approximately 200 yards on left on Blackville Road.
- At the garage property, proceed to the top of the hill.

From Westbrook and Stonington

- Take I-95 southbound (westbound) to Route 8 junction in Bridgeport and follow Route 8 north to split in highway where Route 25 branches off; follow Route 25 north to Newtown; in Newtown, get on I-84 eastbound and follow to Exit 15 in Southbury (Routes 6 and 67 – Southbury).
- At end of exit ramp, turn left to follow Route 6 East and Route 67 North.
- Follow Route 6 to Route 47 in Woodbury; turn left onto Route 47 North at intersection with traffic light and white church with tall steeple (approximately 5.3 miles)
- Follow Route 47 to center of Washington Depot in Washington; Turn right onto Bee Brook Road (Route 47 will turn right, which will also be Route 109 East).
- After approximately one quarter mile, turn right onto Blackville Road (Route 109 East)
- Municipal garage will be approximately 200 yards on left on Blackville Road.
- At the garage property, proceed to the top of the hill.

From Salisbury

- Follow Route 7 southbound to Route 45 in Cornwall; turn left onto Route 45 and follow to Route 202 in New Preston.
- Turn left onto Route 202 and follow to Route 47 (approximately 1.2 miles); turn right onto Route 47 and follow to Route 109 east (Blackville Road – approximately 2.8 miles) and turn left onto Blackville Road.
- Municipal garage will be approximately 200 yards on left on Blackville Road.
- At the garage property, proceed to the top of the hill.

To Hearing/Town Hall

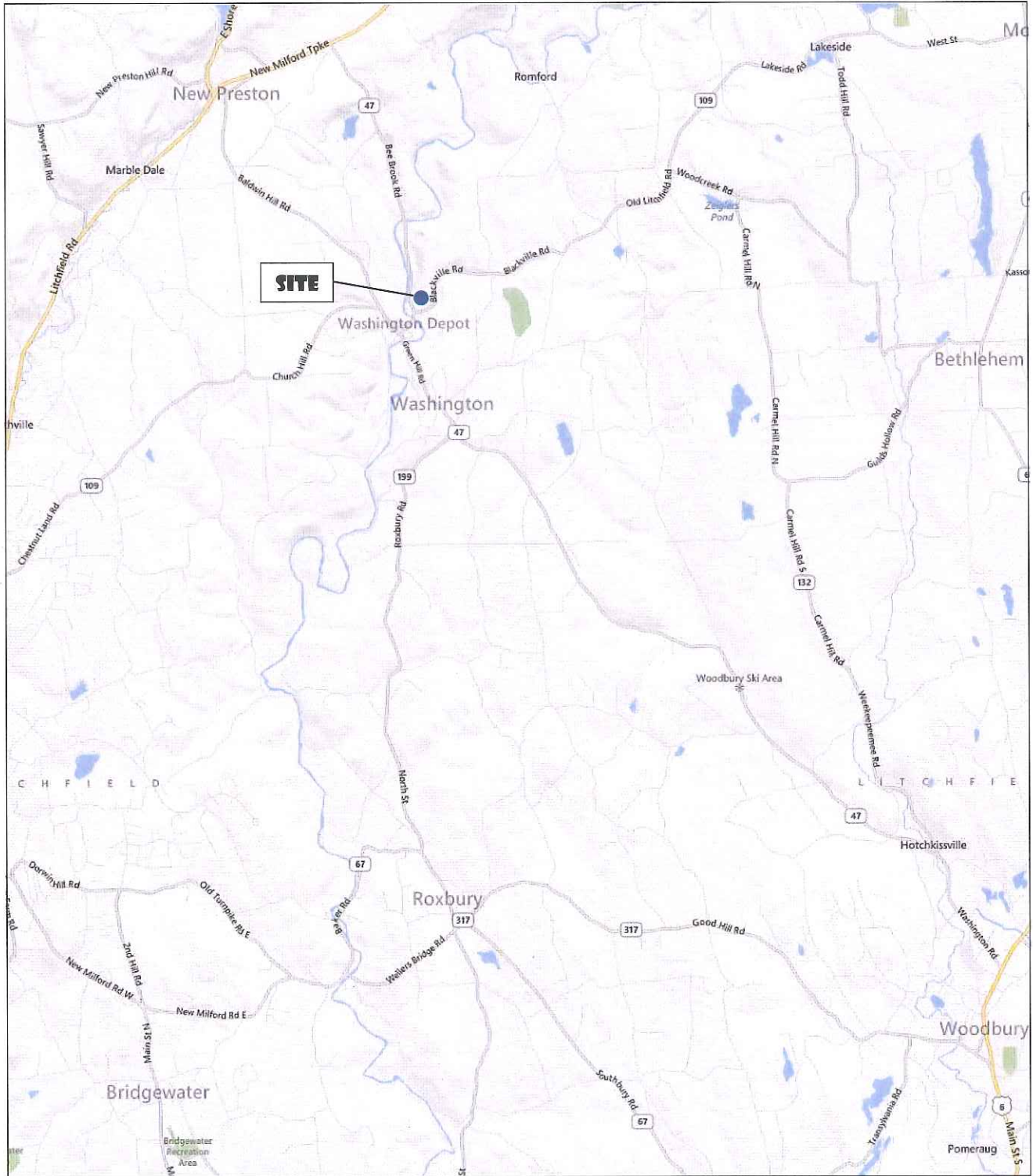
- From site, turn right onto Blackville Road and then left onto Route 47 at intersection with Bee Brook Road.
- In center of Washington Depot, Route 47 will turn left and Route 109 will turn right. Town Hall will be diagonally across the street; it is the large brick building with a tall white cupola topped with a golden dome. Parking is on the street.

To Restaurant

Dinner will be at GW Tavern, 20 Bee Brook Road in Washington, 860-868-6633.

- From Washington Town Hall, return to Route 47 and head northbound (back toward site).
- Restaurant will be approximately 270 yards on right.
