#### Dear First Selectman Pemberton:

We are writing to you on behalf of Message Center Management with respect to a project to replace an existing wireless telecommunications tower facility at the Redding Ridge Fire Department site. The purpose of our letter is to commence a formal consultation process with you and other Town officials prior to any application being filed by MCM and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") with the State Siting Council. Enclosed you will find a detailed Technical Report for the proposed facility which includes information on the need for the replacement tower and the environmental effects of the project as identified at this time.

#### Background and Need for a Replacement Tower

As you are probably aware, a relatively short lattice tower exists at the fire department currently and hosts radio communication antennas and equipment for both the fire department and the Town of Redding. In 2007 the Connecticut Siting Council approved a new monopole tower at this same location for Sprint Nextel Corporation. That facility was never built and the certificate issued by the Siting Council subsequently expired. AT&T and other wireless carriers have gaps in reliable service in the Redding Ridge area and MCM is proposing to replace the tower in accordance with an agreement reached with the Redding Fire Company No. 1.

#### The Tower Project

MCM is a company that specializes in the development of tower infrastructure needed to serve a community's wireless communications needs and works closely with commercial wireless carriers and public safety agencies. MCM confirmed the need for a new tower in this geographic area with AT&T and has proposed a monopole tower replacement in conjunction with the fire department. MCM would own, maintain and operate the tower facility subject to any approval the State Siting Council may issue for the project.

The project as currently proposed would consist of a 150' monopole structure within a fenced compound. Town and fire department communications antennas would be installed on the new tower. AT&T's antennas would be installed at the top level of the tower with equipment



installed at grade within the compound. The tower and fenced area are further designed to support the antennas and equipment of four other FCC licensed wireless carriers. Access to the facility will be extended from Black Rock Turnpike and utilities are planned to connect to an existing pole on site. The facility will be unmanned with no sanitary or water facilities and generates on average 1 vehicle trip per month by each wireless carrier consisting of a service technician in a light duty van or truck.

### State Considerations - Balance Need for a Tower with Environmental Effects

Connecticut State policy generally recognizes the need for new towers to serve the public and has designated the State Siting Council as the state agency with responsibility for reviewing specific tower proposals. The Siting Council's focus is on balancing the need for a tower on a case by case basis with any significant adverse environmental effects. In this regard we note that the Siting Council previously found a need for a replacement tower facility in this area and had approved a similar project in 2007.

The Siting Council will be called upon to evaluate this new proposal once an application is filed with the agency. The Siting Council's focus is on balancing the need for a tower on a case by case basis with any significant adverse environmental effects. In this regard we note the following initial findings by the project sponsors as set forth more fully in the enclosed Technical Report:

- This replacement tower will bring new reliable AT&T wireless service to residents of Redding and provide service along State Route 58 as well as to a number of local roads and residences.
- As an already developed parcel with a tower, environmental effects principally involve comparative visibility of the replacement tower structure at a higher height. As noted in the preliminary visibility assessment included in the Technical Report, visibility will be further evaluated with a comprehensive field-verified analysis but it is expected that topography and tree cover will limit overall visibility of the tower.
- Recommendations of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection will be implemented during and after construction to address the potential for eastern box turtles in this area of Redding.
- As an existing tower site, there is a State preference for siting at this location and there are no other known viable alternatives.

The Siting Council will be called upon to evaluate these and other factors once an application is filed with the agency and based on the facts, it is the project sponsors' belief that the need for a new tower to serve the community is evident and that on balance, any environmental impact is not significant and can be appropriately mitigated.

#### Town Input & Procedural Next Steps

We are providing the enclosed Technical Report to the Town of Redding in accordance with Section 16-50*l* of the Connecticut General Statutes, which requires consultation with a municipality in which a tower facility is proposed prior to submission of an application with the Siting Council. As noted, jurisdiction over any proposed cellular tower facility rests exclusively with the Siting Council and would be in lieu of local zoning, wetlands and other types of municipal land use review and approvals. As such, the purpose of local consultation is to give the municipality in which a facility has been proposed an opportunity to provide the prospective applicant with any recommendations or preferences it may have prior to the filing of an application with the Siting Council.

Upon review of Section 16-50*l*(g) of the Connecticut General Statutes, you will note that municipalities have the option of conducting a noticed public information session on any proposed cellular tower facility. State law requires any such public information session to be held by the Town during the first sixty days of the ninety day period afforded to municipalities for consultation with a prospective Siting Council applicant. As such, should you elect to conduct a public information meeting regarding this project, it would need to occur sometime prior to March 2, 2014. For such public information sessions, our typical practice is for introductions to be made by a municipal official, have the project team make a presentation (usually powerpoint) and then respond to public questions moderated by a local official or agency.

In advance, we thank you for your consideration and will follow this correspondence with a call to your office to discuss next steps in greater detail and who you may want to designate in the Town in administering the consultation process on behalf of the Town. We look forward to meeting with the Town further on this project and learning more about Redding's interests, concerns and any recommendations prior to filing an application with the State Siting Council.

# Subject: Proposed Wireless Telecommunications Facility, 186 Black Rock Turnpike, Redding, CT, Possible project impacts on significant cultural resources

Dear Mr. Libertine,

All-Points Technology Corporation, P.C. (All-Points) is considering construction of a 150 foot tall telecommunications tower (the Project) at 168 Black Rock Turnpike in the Town of Redding, CT. This Project will be reviewed by the Connecticut Siting Council and the Connecticut State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) under provisions of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (as amended) to determine possible adverse Project effects on properties listed on, or potentially eligible for listing on, the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP), including properties currently listed on the Connecticut State Register of Historic Places (SRHP).

The proposed Project will be located on Redding Ridge, one of the earliest places in Redding that were settled by Europeans during the early 1700s. In 1999, the Redding Selectmen sponsored an historical and archeological assessment of Redding (Reeve 1999, now being updated) to identify historic structures and archeological sensitivity, including properties that are presently within a one mile radius of the proposed Project (Figure 1). As described in Table 1, historically sensitive properties within the one-mile radius include 8 archeological sites, 22 structures possibly built during the 1700s, 48 structures from the 1800s, and at least 148 structures from the early 1900s (50 years old or greater) that are possibly eligible for listing on the NRHP. These include 8 properties presently listed on the Connecticut SRHP:

- 228 Black Rock Turnpike;
- 238 Black Rock Turnpike;
- 256 Black Rock Turnpike;
- 9 Church Hill Road;
- 105 Cross Highway;
- 176 Cross Highway;
- 230 Poverty Hollow Road; and
- Poverty Hollow Stone Bridge.

The proposed Project might have adverse visual effects on these and perhaps other historic properties. The Redding Center Historic District is less than two miles west from the proposed Project. In addition, recent studies in Poverty Hollow recommended NRHP historic districts for properties that are less than one mile east from the proposed Project (von Jena and Reeve 2005).

We specifically request that All-Points study visual impacts of alternative tower heights and designs on properties listed on the NRHP and SRHP. We also request that the Redding Planning Commission should be informed when All-Points is conducting visual analyses of the proposed Project. We further request that the Connecticut Siting Council and SHPO evaluate visual impacts of alternative Project heights and designs to minimize possible adverse effects on historically significant properties, and/or recommend appropriate mitigation measures.


