



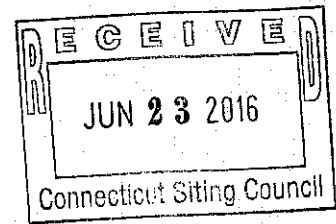

Dear Chairman Stein and Executive Director Bachman:


Please accept this letter from Homeland Towers, LLC and on behalf of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 452 ("Certificate").

Condition 7 of the Decision and Order dated March 5, 2015 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council's Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

Construction has recently begun at the Site. In keeping with Condition 8 of the Decision and Order, we respectfully request an extension of the Certificate's allowed completion time for an additional eighteen months to March 5, 2018 which would provide the necessary extension for AT&T to make arrangements for the installation of their communication data service to the tower site.
