Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after October 6, 2014 by Homeland Towers, LLC ("Homeland") and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") (together the "Applicants") for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility in Salisbury, Connecticut

The proposed facility is located on a parcel of land owned by Salisbury School Inc. with an address. of 250 Canaan Road with access from Canaan Road (Route 44) in the lown of Salisbury and identified on the Town of Salisbury Assessor's Map as Map 16 Lot 5 (the "Property"). The proposed facility is located in the central portion of the Property and is proposed at a height of of 150 abovegrade ("AGL"); designed as a monopine, with faux branches extending to an overall lieight of 157 AGL. The Property is an approximately 169.3 acre parcel which is currently improved with a maintenance garage, campus houses, athletic, fields and undisturbed wooded areas. The Facility is proposed to allow commercial wireless services in Eastern Salisbury. The tower antennas and ground equipment will be located within a 50° by 80°

fenced equipment compound area. Vehicle and utility access to the facility would be from Canaan Roadover an existing access drive, then along an existing gravel drive that will be upgraded and then along an existing logging road 860-435-987 extension that will be upgraded with a gravel surface a distance of approximately 580 to the tower
