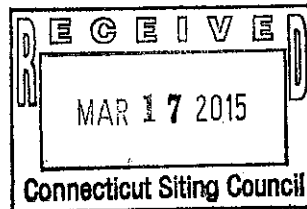

Hi Mike,

I reviewed the information you provided regarding the Docket No.454 –Tower Holdings, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a telecommunications facility located at Farmington Tax Assessor Parcel ID Maps 25 & 26, Lots 3A and 3B, 199 Brickyard Road, Farmington, Connecticut. Our letter of December 29, 2014 indicates that the project is contained within the Aquifer Protection Area (APA) of Connecticut Water Company –Unionville (CT Sand and Stone APA) an active source of public drinking water for the Connecticut Water Company (PWSID #CT0520011) based on the Level B Mapping , which is a preliminary in nature and not formally adopted, as you also indicated in the email below.

I have reviewed the information you provided via email dated March 12, 2015. In comparison with the GIS Mapping system our Department have and DEEP mapping system depicting the APAs boundaries, it appears that the site is not contained within the Aquifer Protection Area (APA) of Connecticut Water Company –Unionville (CT Sand and Stone APA) . The intent of recommendations from DWS to the Siting Council are for protecting the sources of public drinking water during and after project completions.

Good afternoon Mira

Thank you for taking the time to speak with me regarding the Project in Farmington and your willingness to review the attached information. As discusses, your office responded to the CT Siting Council's request for review of our Project in Docket 454 on December 29, 2014 indicating that the Project site is located within an Aquifer Protection Area of the CT Water Company (specifically, the CT Sand & Stone APA) a public water supply.

From what we have been able to ascertain, the project site appears to be located just outside the boundary of the CT Sand & Stone APA. Recognizing the Level B Mapping is preliminary in nature (and not formally adopted), and the fact

that our project site is in close proximity to the aquifer, the applicant is intends to take a conservative approach and incorporate the recommended protective measures summarized in your letter, should the Project be approved by the Siting Council.

For reference, I am including the following documents to assist in your review:

- Your Department's written response to the Siting Council's request for comment on this Docket (December 29, 2014)
- The DEEP's public map depicting the APAs and our site location
- A site specific map incorporating GIS data of the APA boundary

Any clarification you can provide re: the discrepancy between your office's initial determination and our research would be greatly appreciated.
