Tower Holdings will file the Application on or about October 16, 2014.

Tower Holdings seeks to construct a 180 foot lattice structure, which will host the antenna array of New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”). The proposed Facility would provide reliable wireless communications services to local roads and areas in the north-central portions of the Town in the vicinity of the intersection of Brickyard Road and Harris Road as well as Wildwood Road. AT&T needs the Facility, in conjunction with other existing telecommunications facilities in the Town and in the Town of Avon, to provide reliable services to the public.

The Facility would also accommodate the communications equipment of the radio station Soft Rock 106.5 WBMW, Dunning Sand & Gravel and Marcus Communications. Additionally, the Facility would enable Tower Holdings’ affiliate, Northeast Towers, Inc. (“NET”), to use the Facility as a training tower so NET employees and municipal first and second responders can learn about new technologies as they enter the market, and promote safe, efficient and timely installation and repair of towers. The Application will set forth the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and will also describe the environmental impact, if any, of the Facility.
