Dear Mr. Langer:

A Tree Inventory was completed at the subject site on August 1, 2013 to determine the size and quantity of existing trees that will need to be removed for the installation of the proposed facility. The proposed site has suitable access, but clearing and earthwork will be required to improve the access route and to construct the compound area. Installation of the proposed compound area improvements will not require the removal of any trees.

The area to be disturbed for construction of the compound area will be approximately 3,600 square feet of existing gravel area. The area to be cleared is located on the interior of the site and should not be visible to abutters. Existing access exists on site and will not require improvements to connect to the proposed compound. The total combined area of disturbance for compound and utility improvements is 7,500 sf.
