This office represents Tower Holdings, LLC ("Tower Holdings"), the applicant in the above-captioned docket. I write in response to the comments provided by the Department of Public Health ("DPH"), dated December 23, 2014, concerning Tower Holdings' application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for a telecommunications facility at 199 Brickyard Road ("Property"), Farmington, Connecticut ("Application").

Tower Holdings prepared the portion of Attachment 19 of the Application concerning aquifer protection areas based upon publically available information and mapping. That information and mapping demonstrates that the proposed telecommunications facility and the Property are not located within an aquifer protection area. Should the Council determine otherwise, Tower Holdings and the intervenor, New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC ("AT&T"), can work to accommodate the use of a propane fueled back-up generator.
