

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about December 30, 2014, by Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Celco" or the "Applicant"). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications tower and related facility on an approximately 27 acre parcel at 99 East Street in Southington, Connecticut. Celco proposes to construct a 90-foot monopole tower disguised as a pine tree in the western portion of this parcel. Access to the facility compound will extend from East Street. Celco will also install a new 12' x 30' shelter located near the base of the tower to house its radio equipment and a propane-fueled back-up generator. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.

On the day of the Siting Council public hearing on this proposal, Celco will fly a balloon at the height of the proposed tower described above. Interested parties and residents of the Town of Southington are invited to review the Application during normal business hours after December 30, 2014, at any of the following offices:
