The Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") granted a certificate for the above referenced docket to North Atlantic Tower ("NAT") on September 17, 2015.

NAT subsequently transferred all of its rights, title and interest in and to Tarpon Towers II, LLC ("Tarpon") an affiliate of NAT.

Tarpon was created by the owners and managers of NAT following the receipt of new financing which required NAT to move its assets to the new company, Tarpon.

NAT requests that the Certificate granted by Decision and Order on September 17, 2015 in this Docket be transferred to Tarpon. Pursuant to the requirements of Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50k(b), Tarpon agrees to comply with the terms and conditions contained in that Decision and Order. The transfer of this Certificate was not contemplated at any point during or prior to the Council's approval of the Docket No. 458 Certificate.
