4. What is the process that businesses will follow to receive compensation for lost business?
5. What compensation will Eversource provide to businesses severing their rental leases as a result of Eversource's proposal being accepted by the CT Siting Council?
6. What is the projected EMF exposure from the substation and the transmission lines to businesses along 280 Railroad Avenue?
