RE: **DOCKET NO. 461** - Eversource Energy application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV underground transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements.

1. Motions.

During the public hearing held by the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) on December 1, 2015, the Council voted on the following:

a. Office of Consumer Counsel Motion for Additional Hearing, dated November 24, 2015:

The Office of Consumer Counsel's Motion for an Additional Hearing was granted.

b. Eversource Energy Request for Administrative Notice, dated November 24, 2015:

The Applicant's Request for Administrative Notice was granted.

2. Continuation of the Evidentiary Hearing.

The Council shall continue the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced proceeding on **Tuesday, January 12, 2016**, in Hearing Room One, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at **11:00 a.m.**

The hearing shall commence with the appearances and cross examination of the parties and intervenors in the order listed on the hearing program. Thereafter, the hearing will continue with the continued cross examination of the Applicant.

To save the time and expense of the parties, intervenors and the public, and to conclude this proceeding in a timely and efficient fashion, the Council requests that all parties and intervenors submit interrogatories to the Applicant and other parties and intervenors on or before the close of business on **December 22, 2015**. This is the final deadline for submission of additional interrogatories.

Also to save the time and expense of the parties, intervenors and the public, and to conclude this proceeding in a timely and efficient fashion, the Council requests that all parties and intervenors submit responses to interrogatories, pre-filed testimony, late-filed exhibits and briefs regarding C.G.S. §16-50p(g) on or before the close of business on **January 5, 2016**. This is the final deadline for additional pre-filed testimony.

All testimony is required to be pre-filed in writing and distributed to the service list in accordance with the above schedule. Direct testimony at the hearings is not permitted.



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Any request for an extension of time to submit pre-filed testimony and responses to interrogatories shall be submitted to the Council in writing pursuant to §16-50j-22a of the Regulation of Connecticut State Agencies.
