Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of May 21, 2020, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow for one additional work hour this evening (May 21), from 6 PM to 7 PM, in order to complete concrete work associated with the Indian Harbor Pedestrian Bridge that has been delayed by traffic on I-95.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hour requested in your email of May 21, 2020. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on May 24, 2019. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource is requesting an extension of work hours for this evening beyond the 6 PM curfew until 7 PM for work related to the construction of the Indian Harbor pedestrian bridge along Davis Avenue in Greenwich. The reason for the request is that, due to traffic on I-95 being backed from Norwalk to Greenwich caused by a Connecticut DOT construction project, the concrete trucks cannot make the required number of trips to finish the concrete pour for the western bridge abutment in time to meet the 6 PM curfew.

The Town of Greenwich has been notified and they understand and have no issues with the extended hours.
