RE: **DOCKET NO. 461A** - Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of June 12, 2020, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan to allow for two additional work hours this evening (June 12), from 6 PM to 8 PM, to complete concrete and flow fill work at the duct bank located on Railroad Avenue.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of June 12, 2020. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan (Vol. 2, Part 1) on January 17, 2019. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

Eversource is requesting an extension of work hours for this evening beyond the 6 PM curfew until 8 PM for duct bank installation activities on Railroad Avenue. The duct bank has been excavated and conduit installed. In the process of excavating, large boulders were encountered which led to a condition where the recommended course of action in order to return the road in a safe condition is to complete the placement of concrete and flow fill in order to fill the voids created by the boulders. The first concrete truck was due to arrive at 1PM however has been delayed. The work calls for two truckloads of concrete and eight trucks of flow fill.

The Town of Greenwich has been notified and they understand and have no issues with the extended hours.
