Dear Ms. Bellion:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of June 16, 2020, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan - Traffic Management Plan to allow for a work shift from 7 AM to 6 PM, Monday through Friday for construction segments 1, 2, and 4 associated with the Indian Harbor Crossing. The change in work hours would be effective from June 22, 2020 through July 31, 2020.

This approval applies only to the temporary change in work hour requested in your email of June 16, 2020. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan (Vol. 2, Part 2) on May 24, 2019. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

The Indian Harbor Crossing D&M Plan, Appendix D, Traffic Management Plan, identifies four segments, each with specific work hours, for the construction of the pedestrian bridge over Davis Mill Pond and the cable route sections leading to either side of the bridge. The construction of the bridge itself constitutes one segment (referred to as Segment 3); the remaining three segments (Segments 1, 2, and 4) pertain to the cable route sections located immediately to the east and west of the bridge.

Currently, along Segments 1, 2, and 4, the TMP defines different Monday-Friday work hours for trenching/duct bank installation/restoration. To facilitate the coordination and completion of the trenching/duct bank installation/restoration along these three segments, Eversource proposes that the Monday-Friday work hours for Segments 1, 2, and 4 be modified to consistently be 7 AM to 6 PM, Monday to Friday, shown as follows:

Eversource seeks these weekday (Monday-Friday) work hour changes from Monday, June 22, 2020 through Friday, July 31, 2020.

These modified hours will be consistent with the current 7 AM to 6 PM Monday-Friday work hours for the construction of the underground transmission line (trenching, duct bank installation) along the rest of Davis Avenue (from Vault 4A/4B to the west).

During construction, Greenwich police will be on hand to direct traffic.

The Town of Greenwich has been notified and they understand and have no issues with the proposed work hour modifications.
