**DOCKET NO. 461A** - Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements. Underground Transmission Line.

Dear Ms. Bellion:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (b) and in response to your email of December 4, 2019, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) staff hereby approves a temporary change to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for additional construction hours necessary to complete trenching and duct bank installation for the underground transmission line west of Vault 4A/B to Museum Drive as expeditiously as possible. The change in work hours includes the proposed work shift from 7 AM to 6 PM Monday through Friday, instead of the previously approved work shift of 9 AM to 3 PM.

This approval applies only to the temporary additional work hours requested in your email of December 4, 2019. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on January 17, 2019. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Eversource Energy requests the Connecticut Siting Council staff approve extended work hours to more efficiently and expeditiously trench and install the duct bank along Davis Avenue (heading west from Vault 4A/4B) and Indian Harbor Drive to Museum Drive (D&M Plan, Vol 2 – Part 1, Mapsheets 10 of 17 and 11 of 17; Appendix C, Traffic Management Plan [TMP] Segments 16-19) The proposed additional work hours are **Monday through Friday, from 7 AM to 9 AM and from 3 PM to 6 PM for all trenching and duct bank installation activities starting December 9, 2019 and estimated to continue through March 2020.** 

The currently approved weekday hours for work within these segments, per the TMP, are 9 AM to 3 PM Monday through Friday (refer to the TMP Section 4.1, Segments 16-19).

In its monthly construction progress report for March 2020, Eversource will notify the Council of the exact date that the work was completed and the requested additional hours ended.

Eversource has consulted with representatives of the Town of Greenwich regarding the extended work hour request.
