RE: **DOCKET NO. 461A** - Eversource Energy Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115-kilovolt (kV) bulk substation located at 290 Railroad Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut, and two 115-kV transmission circuits extending approximately 2.3 miles between the proposed substation and the existing Cos Cob Substation, Greenwich, Connecticut, and related substation improvements.

Dear Ms. Shanley:

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b) and in accordance with the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) Decision and Order for the above referenced project dated November 9, 2017, Council staff hereby approves the use of an additional temporary staging area/laydown yard at 24 Garden Street in Stamford, as detailed in Eversource's correspondence dated April 22, 2020.

The additional temporary staging area/laydown yard is located on an approximately 0.11-acre privately owned and presently undeveloped parcel at 24 Garden Street adjacent to the intersection with Dock Street in Stamford. The staging area/laydown yard is located in an area of mixed urban land uses and is not adjacent to any environmental resources.

The staging area/laydown yard would be used to store the 115-kV cable reels, including equipment and other supplies used in the cable installation process. An office trailer, dumpsters, and sanitary facilities would also be located on the site.

This approval applies only to the temporary staging area/laydown yard presented in Eversource's request of April 22, 2020. Any additional changes to the D&M Plan require advance notification and approval in accordance with the Council's approval of the D&M Plan on January 17, 2019. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62. Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.

Dear Ms. Bachman:

For the Greenwich Substation and Line Project (Project), The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) is preparing for the phase of construction involving the installation of the 115-kilovolt (kV) underground cable. Pursuant to Sections C.2.1 and F.2 of the Project's above-referenced Development and Management Plan (D&M Plan or Plan) and the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council's) January 17, 2019 approval of that Plan, Eversource seeks Council staff approval for the use of an additional staging area / laydown yard.

The proposed staging area / laydown yard is located at 24 Garden Street (adjacent to the intersection with Dock Street), Stamford, Connecticut. The staging area / laydown yard would be used to store the large reels that hold the 115-kV cable, as well as to rack materials and store equipment and other supplies used in the cable installation process. An office trailer, dumpsters, and sanitary facilities also would be located on the site.

The approximately 0.11-acre, fenced site is privately-owned and is presently undeveloped. The site is in an area of mixed urban land uses and is not adjacent to any environmental resources.

The attached maps illustrate the location of the proposed staging area / laydown yard, for which Eversource's contractor has obtained a lease agreement. After the completion of the cable installation process, the site would be restored in accordance with landowner requirements.
