RE: **DOCKET NO. 465** - The United Illuminating Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115/13.8-kilovolt (kV) replacement substation facility located on an approximately 1.5 acre portion of two adjoining UI-owned parcels directly adjacent to UI's existing Baird Substation, 1770 Stratford Avenue, Stratford, Connecticut, and related transmission structure and interconnection improvements.

Dear Attorney Morrissey:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated September 11, 2017, regarding the revision to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced substation facility that was approved by the Council on September 1, 2016.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62(b), your request to change the color of the fencing from green to grey opaque winged slats is hereby approved. The United Illuminating Company consulted with the abutting property owner, Two Roads Brewing Company, and the abutter prefers the grey color.

This approval applies only to the D&M Plan revision dated September 11, 2017. Any significant changes to the D&M Plan require advance Council notification and approval.

Please be advised that deviations from this plan are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62.
