DOCKET NO. 466 FROST BRIDGE TO CAMPVILLE 115-kV PROJECT MONTHLY CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS REPORT AUGUST 2018

1. NEW 115-kV TRANSMISSION LINE AND RELATED TRANSMISSION LINE MODIFICATIONS

During August, crews continued to perform restoration and final stabilization work along the transmission line right-of-way (ROW). The ROW restoration work is expected to be completed in early September.

Eversource also continued to perform routine inspections to verify the integrity of erosion and sedimentation controls and to monitor the ROW restoration work.

2. MODIFICATIONS TO FROST BRIDGE AND CAMPVILLE SUBSTATIONS

All Project modifications to both Frost Bridge and Campville substations were completed as of the end of May 2018.

3. MINOR DEVELOPMENT & MANAGMENT (D&M) PLAN CHANGES

No minor D&M Plan changes were identified in August 2018.
