Decision and Order Condition #8 – Third Year Operating Report**


Dear Melanie Bachman:

On April 16, 2018, in Docket 466, the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) of the Frost Bridge to Campville 115-kV Project (Modifications to the Frost Bridge and Campville Substation, and New 115-kV Transmission Line and Related Transmission Line Modifications.) Condition #8 of the Council’s Decision & Order directed that Eversource “provide the Council an operating report within three months after the conclusion of the first year of operation of all facilities herein, and annually thereafter for a period of three years, with information relative to the condition, safety, reliability and operation of the transmission systems”.

In compliance with Condition #8, Eversource herewith submits that the overall operating condition and safety of the new 115-kV line extending from Eversource’ Frost Bridge Substation to Campville Substation and related substation modifications has been excellent. There have been no forced outages since the line went into service.
