Notice of Application by The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy for Approval of a New 115-kV Electric Transmission Line in the Municipalities of Bethel, Danbury, and Brookfield, Connecticut

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 16-50*l*(b) of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Section 16-50*l*-1(e) of the regulations of the Connecticut Siting Council, and the Application Guide for an Electric and Fuel Transmission Line Facility of the Connecticut Siting Council (adopted February 2016), notice is hereby given that The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) will on or about June 30, 2016, submit an Application to the Connecticut Siting Council seeking a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Application) for the Southwest Connecticut Reliability Project (Project).

The Project includes construction of a new approximately 3.4-mile 115-kilovolt (kV) overhead electric transmission line between Eversource's existing Plumtree Substation (located at 16 Walnut Hill Road in the Town of Bethel) and Brookfield Junction in the Town of Brookfield, related modifications to Plumtree Substation and Stony Hill Substation (located at 49 Stony Hill Road in the Town of Brookfield), and the reconfiguration of two existing 115-kV transmission lines that presently connect to Stony Hill Substation. All of the proposed Project facilities will be located within Eversource's existing, long-established right-of-way (ROW), which extends through portions of Bethel, Danbury, and Brookfield, or on Eversource-owned properties in those municipalities.

The Project is needed to bring the electric supply system in the Housatonic Valley-Norwalk-Plumtree electrical sub-area of Southwest Connecticut into compliance with national and regional reliability standards and criteria by eliminating potential thermal overloads and voltage violations identified in studies conducted by Independent System Operator-New England, the regional system planning authority.

The Application will describe the need for the Project; identify the proposed Project facilities; characterize the existing environmental conditions along the Proposed Route for the new 115-kV transmission line and at the Plumtree and Stony Hill substations; evaluate the Project's potential environmental and social impacts, along with measures to mitigate such impacts; and discuss the alternate routes and configurations considered for the new transmission line, including an evaluation of the environmental, engineering, reliability, operability, and cost considerations associated with those alternatives. If approved by the Connecticut Siting Council, Project construction is expected to begin in the first quarter of 2018. The new transmission line is proposed to be completed and in-service by the end of 2018.
