Dear Ms. Bachman:

On November 16, 2016 in Docket 468, the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") Southwest Connecticut Reliability Project ("SWCT"). Condition 8 of the Council's Decision and Order directed that Eversource "provide the Council an operating report within three months after the conclusion of the first year of operation all facilities herein and annually thereafter for a period of three years, with information relative to the condition, sfety, reliability, and operation of the transmission systems.

Eversource submits the following information to the Council in compliance with Condition #8.

As of September 19, 2018, the transmission facilities and restoration were deemed complete for this project. The overall condition and safety of the 115-kV line and associated facilities extending from Plumtree Substation in the Town of Bethel to Brookfield Junction in the Town of Brookfiled has been excellent. There have been no forced optages in the last calendar year.

This report represents the third-year operating report.
