RE: **DOCKET NO. 470B** – NTE Connecticut, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 550-megawatt dual-fuel combined cycle electric generating facility and associated electrical interconnection switchyard located at 180 and 189 Lake Road, Killingly, Connecticut. Reopening of this application based on changed conditions pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b).

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The Council shall continue the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced proceeding on Thursday, May 2, 2019, in Hearing Room One, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at **11:00 a.m.**

The hearing shall commence with the appearance of the grouped parties (Not Another Power Plant, Sierra Club, and Wyndham Land Trust) to be cross examined by the Council and parties and intervenors in the order listed in the April 18, 2019 Hearing Program.

Thereafter, the hearing shall continue with final cross examination of the applicant by the parties and intervenors in the following order:

1. Not Another Power Plant/Wyndham Land Trust; and
2. Town of Killingly.

The hearing shall conclude with final cross examination of the applicant by the Council.

The final deadline for submission of **pre-filed testimony** expired on **Thursday, April 11, 2019**. **Direct testimony at the hearings is not permitted.** This applies to all parties and intervenors.
