

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments regarding Docket No. 470B.

Due to this proposed project's proximity to airport infrastructure, we believe it will be necessary for the proponents to file Form FAA 7460, Notice of Proposed Construction or Alteration, with the Federal Aviation Administration. This is a necessary step so the FAA can determine if the project will result in a hazard to air navigation. While the project proponents completed the 7460 process in the past, we believe that the last determination has expired, and we respectfully request that the proponents initiate the process again to ensure the safety of aviation in the area.
