Dear Chairman Stein and Members of the Siting Council:

Please accept this letter from Homeland Towers, LLC regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 473 ("Certificate").

Condition 6 of the Decision and Order dated September 14, 2017 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen (18) months from the date of the mailing of the Council's Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

At this time, we wish to advise the Council that construction of the Facility is complete. Verizon is on-air and operational as of January 9, 2019. The actual cost of construction for Verizon was \$62,953.88 and for Homeland Towers it was \$452,207.00. Additionally, please note that AT&T recently filed for a Building Permit and we expect them to be fully operational soon as well.
