THE CHAIRMAN: Good evening, ladies and gentlemen. I'd like to call to order this public hearing of the Connecticut Siting Council today, Tuesday, January 23, 2018, at approximately 6:30 p.m.

My name is Robin Stein. I'm Chairman of the Connecticut siting Council. Other members of the Council present are Senator James Murphy, our Vice Chairman; Mr. Hannon, our designee from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Mr. Levesque, designee from the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority; Mr. Silvestri; and Mr. Harder.

Members of the staff present are Melanie Bachman, our Executive Director Staff Attorney; and Michael Perrone, our citing analyst.

This is a continuation of a public hearing that began at 3 p.m. this afternoon. Copies of the hearing program and citizen's guide to Siting Council procedures are near the door for members of the public.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provisions of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes and of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act upon an application from Tarpon

Towers II, LLC, and Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 380 Horace Street in Bridgeport, Connecticut. The application was received by the Council on September 25, 2017.

This application is also governed by the Telecommunications Act of 1996 which is administered by the Federal Communications Commission. This act prohibits the Council from considering the health effects of radio frequency emissions on human health and wildlife to the extent that emissions from towers are within federal acceptable safe limit standards, which standard is also followed by the State Department of Public Health.

The federal act also prohibits the Council from discriminating among and between providers of functionally equivalent services. This means that if one carrier already provides service for an area other carriers have the right to compete and provide service in the same area. The applicant published notice of the
filing of the application to the Council in the Connecticut Post on September 21st and September 22, 2017. The Council's legal notice of the date and time of the hearing was published in the Connecticut Post on November 20, 2017.

Upon this Council's request the applicant erected a sign at the proposed site so as to inform the public of the nature of the applicant, type of facility, hearing date, time and location, and contact information for the Council.

This afternoon members of the Council, staff and public personally conducted a field review of the proposed site in order to observe firsthand the potential effects of the proposal.

As you're aware, there is a sign-up sheet for those who wish to participate. A reminder to all off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or member of the Council staff upon the merits of the application is prohibited by law.

I wish to note for those who are here and for the benefit of your friends and neighbors who are unable to join us for the public comment session that you or they may send written
statements to the Council within 30 days of the date hereof, and such written statements will be given the same weight as if spoken at the hearing. Please be advised that the Council cannot answer questions from the public about the proposal. A verbatim transcript will be made of this hearing and deposited at the Bridgeport City Clerk's office for the convenience of the public.

Okay. First, I would like to request the applicant to make a very brief presentation explaining where the facility is proposed, why it's necessary and what alternatives were investigated.

THE WITNESS (Roberts): Again, my name is Doug Roberts. I'm an architect with the Hudson Design Group. I'll just briefly walk through the plans.

This is our subject site --
THE CHAIRMAN: Excuse me. Can you make
sure that that lady can see?
THE WITNESS (Roberts): I'm sorry. I thought I was moving it into the light. Please forgive me.

This is our subject site right here,
which is 13 acres. It does have a building that
encumbers a fairly large portion of it. Our proposal is up at this corner here.

The site plan consists of a 60 by 40-foot compound that we have located in this location here just off the pavement, and we are going to be looking to place a 90-foot monopole in that location with a compound for equipment and our backup generator.

We'll be running utilities underground from Rhodes Street all the way over to this site. And this is pretty much the layout for the tower as it stands on the top of the platform. The equipment is in this location. Transformer, electrical meter bank is in this location, underground utilities. And that's pretty much the development of the site.

One of the things we did talk about at the dinner break was possibly looking to -- if you go to C3, looking at placing along the west side some plantings along on that property line and that road. Something, you know, that would be kind of something that would be green all year long and will eventually grow up.

It's certainly not going to be able to hide a 90-foot monopole, but along that edge, the
foreground, the houses are not multiple stories. It will do a fair amount of screening for that. So that was one thing we did discuss.

THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. Thank you.
Now we go to the sign-up sheet. Helen
Olga Losak, if you can go up to the podium? If you could spell your last name to make sure we have it correctly.

HELEN OLGA LOSAK: Okay. Good evening, council. My name is Helen Olga Losak. My last name is spelled $L-0-s-a-k$. I am an elected member of the 138th District Democratic Town Committee. I represent all the neighborhoods surrounding 380/400 Horace Street, the Germania Club.

We are opposed to the building of the cell tower on Horace Street. This is where the Germanian club is located. The club is a gathering place for many people and organizations. This location is highly residential with one, two and three-family homes. There are many businesses and restaurants on this upper part of East Main Street .

There also are two elementary schools, Beardsley School and Thomas Hooker School. Additionally several daycare and preschools and a
church are also situated here.
Cell towers are known to give off high frequencies and high concentrations of radiation linked to many kinds of cancers. The radius of this proposed cell tower's emissions would be widespread past Horace Street.

Several Midwest studies in America have reported a definite connection to cell tower radiation emissions affecting and causing cancers in adults and youngsters living near these cell towers. Wildlife, animals and pets have also developed cancers from cell tower radiation exposure. Studies from Spain, Denmark, the United Kingdom, Germany and Australia confirm high rates of various cancers in adults, youth and animals living near cell towers.

My district is comprised of many hard-working adults, school-aged children, elderly, the disabled and cancer survivors. We do not want this cell tower at Horace Street because of the great health risk of various cancers we the residents would be exposed to.

A better fit for this cell tower would be on the outskirts of the city of Bridgeport away from residential homes, churches, schools and
businesses.
And I thank you this evening for your understanding. This is for the public record and I'm going to turn in this signed letter.

Thank you.
THE CHAIRMAN: Thank you.
I guess I can't really ask if anybody else wants to speak since there doesn't seem to be anybody else.

Before closing this hearing the Connecticut Siting Council announces that briefs and proposed findings of fact may be filed with the Council no later than February 22, 2018. A submission of briefs and proposed findings of fact are not required by this Council. Rather we leave it to the choice of the applicant.

Anyone who has not become a party, but who wishes to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the Council within 30 days of the date hereof.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter a party may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing
will be filed in the Bridgeport City Clerk's office. I hereby declare this hearing adjourned. And thank you all your participation, and drive home safely.
