Re: Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Construction and Operation of a new Pequonnock Substation in Bridgeport, Connecticut

Dear Chairman Stein:

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes ("CGS") § 15-50(a), The United Illuminating Company ("UI") hereby submits to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Application") for the construction of a new Pequonnock Substation in Bridgeport, Connecticut ("Project"). The Project includes the construction and operations of a new gas-insulated substation ("GIS") to be located on an approximate 3.7 acre site at 1 Kiefer Street in Bridgeport and the relocation of the existing transmission and distribution lines that connect the existing Pequonnock substation. After the associated transmission and distribution liens are connected and the new substation is placed into service, the existing Pequonnock Substation will be decommissioned.

By this letter, UI submits to the Council an original and 15 paper copies of the Application, along with an electronic copy (compact disc) of the Application.

In accordance with CGS § 16-50(b) and the Council's *Application Guide for an Electric Substation Facility* (June 2016), UI also encloses the following:

In addition, UI encloses the following:

- A "Bulk Filing" that includes two copies of the following: (i) Zoning & Subdivision Regulations, City of Bridgeport; (ii) Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Regulations, City of Bridgeport; (iii); Bridgeport Master Plan of Conservation and Development; (iv) Connecticut Inland Wetlands Soils Map, Bridgeport, CT; (v) City of Bridgeport Zoning Map; (vi) South End Neighborhood Revitalization Zone Strategic Plan; and (vii) UI's Municipal Consultation Filing. The Municipal Consultation Filing contains everything that UI provided to Bridgeport in regard to the Project. UI's Application contains a summary of the interaction between the Company and the City. Electronic versions of these documents are on the enclosed disk.
- A check for the Application filing fee in the amount of \$25,250.
- A check for the municipal participation fee in the amount of \$25,000.




