RE: **DOCKET NO. 483** - The United Illuminating Company Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Pequonnock Substation Rebuild Project that entails construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115/13.8-kilovolt (kV) gas insulated replacement substation facility located 700 feet southwest of UI's existing Pequonnock substation on an approximately 3.7 acre parcel owned by PSEG Power Connecticut, LLC at 1 Kiefer Street, Bridgeport, Connecticut, and related transmission structure and interconnection improvements.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §16-50j-62 (a) and in accordance with the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) approval of the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above referenced project dated August 28, 2020, Council staff hereby approves the use of a temporary construction laydown area located north of Whiting Street and between Broad Street and Main Street, as detailed in UI's correspondence dated September 7, 2021.

This approval applies only to the temporary construction laydown area presented in UI's request of September 7, 2021. Any additional changes to the approved D&M Plan require advance notification and approval. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62. Please be advised that deviations from the D&M Plan are enforceable under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u.
