PROJECT SUMMARY

Substation

GIS/Control Building construction continues with the installation of the interior services and equipment. Additionally in the GIS Hall Siemens LCC and GIB equipment continues to be installed and commissioned

PDC switchgear installation and commissioning continues. Transformer cabling installed to feeder positions in PDC basement.

Underground Transmission

HPGF civil contractor completed the first phase of installation of the HPGF cable pipes. Contractor has demobilized and will be returning to complete installation in Q2 2024.

XLPE Contractor excavated, installed conduit, and began backfilling the section from the GIB termination to approx. 20' outside the perimeter fence.

Overhead Transmission

Structures 766SC, 767SC and 768DC were installed on the MNR right-away.
