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THE CHAIRMAN: Good afternoon -- or good evening, ladies and gentlemen. I'd like to call to order this hearing of the Connecticut Siting Council, today Thursday, June 14, 2018, at approximately 6:30 p.m.

My name is Robin Stein. I'm chairman of the Connecticut Siting Council. Other members of the Council present are Senator Murphy, our Vice Chairman; Mr. Hannon, the designee from the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection; Mr. Levesque, designee from the Public Utilities Regulatory authority; Mr. Silvestri; Dr. Klemens; Mr. Edelson; Mr. Harder; and Mr. Lynch.

Members of the staff present are Melanie Bachman, our Executive Director and Staff Attorney; and Michael Perrone, our siting analyst.

This is a continuation of a public hearing that began at 3 p.m. this afternoon.

Copies of the hearing program and the Council's citizen guide to Siting Council procedures are available for members of the public here next to the podium.

This hearing is held pursuant to the provision of Title 16 of the Connecticut General Statutes, and of the Uniform Administrative

Procedure Act upon an application from UI for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the Pequonnock Substation rebuild project that entails construction, maintenance, and operation of a 115/13.8 kilovolt gas insulated replacement substation facility located on an approximately 3.7-acre parcel owned by PSEG Power Connecticut, LLC, at 1 Kiefer Street in Bridgeport, Connecticut.

This application was received by the Council on April 26, 2018. The applicant published notice of the filing of the application to the Council in the Connecticut Post on April 12th and April 16, 2016. The Council's legal notice of the date and time of this hearing was published in the Connecticut Post on May 15, 2018.

Upon this Council's request the applicant erected a sign at the proposed site so as to inform the public of the name of the applicant, type of facility, hearing date and location and contact information for the Council. This afternoon members of the Council, staff and public personally conducted a field review of the proposed site in order to observe firsthand the

potential effects of the proposal.

The hearing tonight has been reserved for the public to make short statements into the record. These public statements are not subject to questions from the applicant or parties, or the Council. And members of the public making statements may not ask questions of the applicant, parties or Council. These statements will become part of the record for the Council, and a sign-up sheet is available for those who wish to participate.

As a reminder to all, off-the-record communication with a member of the Council or a member of the Council staff upon the merits of the application is prohibited by law.

I wish to note for those who are here and for the benefit of your friends and neighbors who are unable to join us for the public comment session, that you or they may send written statements to the Council with the 30 days of the date hereof, and such written statements will be given the same weight as if spoken at the hearing.

A verbatim transcript will be made of this hearing and deposited with the Bridgeport City Clerk's office for the convenience of the public.

I think since we do have a little bit of public or some members of the public, I ask for the applicant to make a very brief presentation of the project.

Thank you.

RICHARD PINTO: Thank you.

My name is Rich Pinto. I'm the project manager for United Illuminating for this proposed project. Just to give you a little background, the existing Pequonnock substation is 115 kV/13-8 open air substation that was built in 1956.

And over the years it has experienced some flooding, twice, Super Storm Sandy and Irene. It also has several asset condition issues regarding maintenance.

so the proposed project is to rebuild and relocate the substation from closer -- adjacent to the Pequonnock River to an adjacent parcel a little bit further inland. So the project would extend the transmission system off the existing catenary system on the CDOT Metro-North right-of-way, and it would also extend three underground cables through that actually cross the Pequonnock River, come across and hit

land just south of the station. And then another 115-kV cable on Ferry Access road. All those cables and the overhead will be rerouted into the new proposed project.

The proposed project is a 115-kV gas insulated switchgear. It's a little bit different than the open-air switchgear that exists there today. Construction is expected to start the fourth quarter of 2019 with a completion date of the fourth quarter of 2021.

THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. Thank you.

I don't have anybody who signed up. Is there anybody from the public who wishes to speak?

(No response.)

THE CHAIRMAN: Okay. There are representatives from the UI here. So if after I close the hearing, if you have any questions you can ask them directly.

The Connecticut Siting Council announces that this hearing will be continued to July 24th, 2018, at 1 p.m., in hearing room 2 at the Council's office in New Britain.

Again, anyone who has not become a party

or intervener, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council may file written statements with the council within 30 days of today.

The Council will issue draft findings of fact and thereafter the applicant or intervener may identify errors or inconsistencies between the Council's draft findings of fact and the record, however no new information, no new evidence, no argument, no reply briefs without our permission will be considered by the Council.

Copies of the transcript of this hearing will be filed at the Bridgeport City Clerk's office.

And therefore I will close the hearing and announce that we are adjourned. Thank you all for your participation, and drive home safely.
