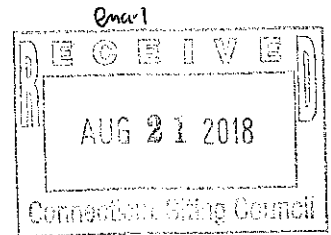

Due to the proposed project's proximity to two private airports, 5CT6 Buell Farm Ultralight and 64CT Woodstock Airport, we respectfully request that the applicant coordinate this project with both airports. Upon initial review, the Connecticut Airport Authority understands that this project could impact the transitional surfaces at both airports, and further coordination will be necessary between the applicant and both airports to determine the severity of those impacts.
