1. Manner in which intervenor's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings:

Steven and Miriam H. Sosnick ("Intervenors") live at 144 Soundview Lane. The Sosnicks will have a line of sight to the cell tower from their bedroom, master bath, deck, front yard and driveway. At the proposed location, the construction of the tower will substantially and specifically affect the value of their property. The tower and compound will adversely impact the natural and rural character of the neighborhood and have a significant negative visual impact.

Connecticut General Statutes Section 4-177a(b)




4. Nature of evidence intervenor intends to present:
