

**BRIDGEPORT ENERGY II, LLC RESPONSES TO
NT-2010 INTERROGATORIES
GENERATORS**

1. If the facility has already been constructed, what versions of the NFPA standards were utilized?

On June 19, 2008, the Connecticut Siting Council issued a declaratory ruling that Bridgeport Energy II, LLC's ("BEII") Bridgeport Peaking Station (the "Facility") would not have a substantial adverse environmental effect, and pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50k would not require a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need with certain conditions. BEII has not performed the engineering necessary to construct the Facility nor has the Facility been constructed.

2. If the facility has yet to be constructed, what versions of the NFPA standards will be utilized?

The facility will be designed and constructed in accordance with the applicable NFPA standards that are available/adopted at the time the Facility is designed and constructed.

3. How would recommendation #6, "Recommendation as to adoption of codes" in the Thomas Commission Executive Report affect the facility?

The facility will be designed and constructed in accordance with the applicable NFPA standards that are available at the time the Facility is designed and constructed.

4. How would the following codes affect construction or modification of the facility:
- a. NFPA 37 (2010 edition);
 - b. NFPA 54 (2009 edition);
 - c. NFPA 54 Temporary Interim Amendment 09-3 (August 25, 2010);
 - d. NFPA 850 (2010 edition);
 - e. NFPA 853 (2010 edition);
 - f. ASME B31; and
 - g. ASME B31.1 Appendices IV and V.

Because the Facility has not yet been designed, each of the noted codes can be incorporated into the final design to extent applicable.

5. What is useful lifespan of the natural gas piping/pipelines located within and to the facility?

As the Facility has not yet been constructed, this question does not apply.

6. Would the natural gas piping/pipelines within and to the facility need to be replaced during the life of the facility?

Gas piping within the Facility would not generally be expected to require replacement.

7. Do you foresee any circumstances that would require replacement of a section of natural gas piping/pipeline within and to the facility?

Not at this time.

8. If so, would a new section of natural gas piping/pipeline within and to the facility be installed and require cleaning?

The need to clean any replaced section of gas piping would be dependent on the specifics of the replacement – extent of replacement, welded joints, flanged joints, etc.

9. What type of material is the natural gas piping/pipeline within and to the facility composed of?

Natural gas piping material will be specified based on the required service and applicable code(s).

10. How many linear feet of natural gas piping/pipeline are located within and to the facility?

The linear feet of gas piping will be determined during design of the Facility.

11. What is operating pressure (psig) of the natural gas piping/pipeline within and to the facility?

The operating pressure will be determined during design of the Facility.

12. What is the nominal pipe size in inches within and to the facility?

The pipe diameter will be determined based during design of the Facility.

13. What is the length in feet of piping/pipeline that requires/required purging within and to the facility?

The length of pipe that may require purging will be determined during design of the Facility.
