The Council is holding this public comment session on the 2022 ten-year forecast of Connecticut electric loads and resources, and the 2022 analysis of life-cycle costs of electric transmission lines pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50r.

The purpose of this proceeding is to examine the adequacy and reliability of electric generation and transmission in the state while considering the cost to consumers and protecting the environment.

The scope of the forecast of loads and resources shall cover the 2022 utility forecast of

loads and resource reports. The scope of the life-cycle cost analysis shall cover all relevant electric transmission line life-cycle costs.

Reports and documents related to the forecasts and life-cycle cost analysis are available for public inspection on the Council's website, and at the Council's office.

This public comment session is reserved for the public to make brief statements into the record. The deadline for the public to sign up to speak during this public comment session was Tuesday, October 18th.

No member of the public signed up to speak.

Any person who desires to make their views known to the Council may file a written statement with the Council by November 19, 2022.

Copies of the transcript of this public comment session will be posted on the Council's forecasts of loads and resources and life-cycle cost analysis webpage under pending matters, and filed at the Council's office at 10 Franklin Square in New Britain, Connecticut.
