1 THE HEARING OFFICER: Good evening, ladies and  
2 gentlemen. This public comment session is called  
3 to order this Wednesday, October 19, 2022, at 6:30  
4 p.m.

5 My name is Melanie Bachman, Executive  
6 Director and Staff Attorney of the Connecticut  
7 Siting Council. Also with us this evening are  
8 Siting Analysts Michael Perrone and Robert  
9 Mercier.

10 If you haven't done so already, I ask that  
11 everyone please mute their computer audio and/or  
12 telephones now.

13 The Council is holding this public comment  
14 session on the 2022 ten-year forecast of  
15 Connecticut electric loads and resources, and the  
16 2022 analysis of life-cycle costs of electric  
17 transmission lines pursuant to Connecticut General  
18 Statutes Section 16-50r.

19 The purpose of this proceeding is to examine  
20 the adequacy and reliability of electric  
21 generation and transmission in the state while  
22 considering the cost to consumers and protecting  
23 the environment.

24 The scope of the forecast of loads and  
25 resources shall cover the 2022 utility forecast of

1 loads and resource reports. The scope of the  
2 life-cycle cost analysis shall cover all relevant  
3 electric transmission line life-cycle costs.

4 Reports and documents related to the  
5 forecasts and life-cycle cost analysis are  
6 available for public inspection on the Council's  
7 website, and at the Council's office.

8 This public comment session is reserved for  
9 the public to make brief statements into the  
10 record. The deadline for the public to sign up to  
11 speak during this public comment session was  
12 Tuesday, October 18th.

13 No member of the public signed up to speak.

14 Any person who desires to make their views  
15 known to the Council may file a written statement  
16 with the Council by November 19, 2022.


17 Copies of the transcript of this public
