The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) will conduct a public comment session on Wednesday, August 10, 2016, to provide an opportunity for public comment on the 2016 Ten-Year Forecast of Connecticut Electric Loads and Resources. The public comment session will be held in Hearing Room Two, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut, beginning at 6:30 p.m., and thereafter as necessary.

Pursuant to CGS 16-50r, the Council shall hold at least one session of a public hearing shall no earlier than 6:30 p.m. The Council will issue a final biennial report in late 2017.
