THE HEARING OFFICER: Ladies and gentlemen, this public comment session is called to order this Wednesday, September 19, 2018, at 6:30 p.m.

My name is Melanie Bachman, Executive

Director, Staff Attorney of the Connecticut Siting

Council and with me this evening is our Siting

Analyst Michael Perrone.

The Connecticut Siting Council is holding this public comment session on the 2018 ten-year forecasted Connecticut electric load and resources in Connecticut, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-50r.

The purpose of this proceeding is to examine the adequacy and reliability of electric generation and transmission of the state while considering the cost to consumers and protecting the environment. Pursuant to these statutory requirements this proceeding will analyze load growth forecasts of the state's electric utilities and plans to meet the demand for electricity through the year 2027.

Included in this analysis will be the following.

Estimated peak loads; resources and

1 margins for each year within the forecast period; 2 data on energy use and peak loads for the five 3 preceding calendar years; existing generating facilities and service; scheduled generating 4 facilities for which property has been acquired 5 for which certificates have been issues, and for 6 which certificate applications have been filed; planned generating units at plant locations for 8 9 which property has been acquired, or plant locations not yet acquired that will needed to 10 provide estimated additional electrical 11 requirements, and the location of such facilities; 12 planned transmission lines on which proposed route 13 reviews are being undertaken or for which 14 certificate applications have already been filed; 15 steps taken to upgrade existing facilities and to 16 17 eliminate overhead transmission and distribution 18 lines; and electricity purchased from private 19 power producers.

A sign-up sheet is available for those who would like to participate. In addition written statements sent to the Council by October 19, 2018, will be given the same weight as oral statements.
