Dear Chairman Caruso:

Please accept this as Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative's (CMEEC) Late Filed Exhibit 1, which is intended as a correction/clarification to Mr. Perrone's question to Mr. Charles Carpinella (witness) about weather normalized peaks for the CMEEC systems.

CMEEC would like to clarify that the overall energy requirements for CMEEC's Members in addition to Wallingford and Bozrah through July 2010 exceeded energy requirements for the same period in 2009 by about 1%. In 2009, CMEEC experienced a colder than normal winter and a much cooler than normal summer. However in 2010, CMEEC had a much milder than normal winter and a much hotter than normal summer. Thus, the net effect so far has been that weather normalized loads in 2010 are *down by about 3.5%* from weather normalized 2009 levels, not up as suggested in oral testimony.
