Technical Correction to CMEEC's February 25, 2010 Forecast Filing

Dear Ms. Roberts:

The Connecticut Municipal Electric Energy Cooperative (CMEEC) recently noticed a discrepancy in figures filed on February 25, 2010 in its initial 2010 Forecast filing. Specifically, Table V includes a list of municipally-owned generating units and information relative to the in-service dates of those units, among other information. For the three Norden Units – Units 1, 2, and 3 – the in-service dates are listed as “2009”. In fact, all three Norden Units began *physical operation* in June, 2008 but served as “behind the meter” resources until 2009, when they began operation in the ISO-NE administered markets.

This clarification should not affect the substance of the Forecast in any meaningful way. However, once we recognized the discrepancy, CMEEC wanted to be sure an explanation and correction was entered into the record. A revised Table V reflecting this correction is attached.
