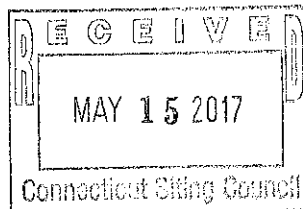

**JOINT MOTION OF THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY DBA

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50j-22a, The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") and The United Illuminating Company ("UI") respectfully request an extension of time to May 23, 2017 to submit responses to the interrogatories issued by the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") in this proceeding.
