Dear Correne Auer:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of correspondence dated November 20, 2025 regarding a revision to Partial Development and Management (D&M) Plan II for the above-referenced facility that was approved by the Council on July 21, 2023.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62 (b), Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to Partial D&M Plan II to allow for work hours between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 23, 2025 in the vicinity of Structures 10 through 13 in the Cities of Ansonia and Derby. The extended work hours are necessary to meet a scheduled outage.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary extended work hours, dated November 20, 2025.

Please be advised that deviations from the Council's Decision and Order and D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA § 16-50j-62.

Pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62(b)(2) and the project's Development & Management Plan approved on July 20, 2023, The United Illuminating Company ("UI") is hereby notifying the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") of a modification. In order to maintain project schedule and complete the removal of the lattice structures between Structures 10 to 13 prior to end of a current outage, work must be conducted on Sunday, 11/23/2025.

The request for the lattice structure removals work on 11/23/2025, is a result of non-project related mechanical issues within a Substation that prevented the outage of the 1594 line.
