Dear Attorney McDermott:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of correspondence dated January 20, 2025 regarding a revision to Partial Development and Management (D&M) Plan II for the above-referenced facility that was approved by the Council on July 21, 2023.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62 (b), Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to Partial D&M Plan II to allow for daily work hours between 7:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. from January 21, 2025 through February 21, 2025 in the vicinity of Structures 14 through 17 in the City of Ansonia. The extended work hours are necessary to comply with Connecticut Department of Transportation encroachment permit requirements, meet a scheduled outage and complete construction at Nolan Sports Complex prior to the spring sports season.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary extended work hours, dated January 20, 2025.

Please be advised that deviations from the Council's Decision and Order and D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA § 16-50j-62.

Pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62(b)(2) and Attachment M to the project's Development & Management Plan approved on July 20, 2023, The United Illuminating Company ("UI") is hereby notifying the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") of a request for modification. The modification being requested is an extension of construction work hours from 7:00 pm to 5:00 am between the dates of 1/21/2025 to 2/21/2025 between monopoles 14 and 17 in Ansonia, CT.

The request for modification is needed to (1) comply with UI's CTDOT Encroachment permit #4022847 requiring the conductor across Route 8 be pulled in at night and, (2) meet transmission system outage dates and the Town of Ansonia's request that construction at Nolan Sports Complex be completed prior to start of their high school spring sports season.

Erosion and sedimentation controls, noise, and lighting mitigation conditions will be implemented during the drilling activities, as needed and in compliance with the Projects SWPCP and D&M Plan.
