The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the correspondence dated December 5, 2024, regarding a revision to Partial Development and Management (D&M) Plan II for the above-referenced facility that was approved by the Council on July 21, 2023.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62(b), your request to shift the construction entrance off Hawkins Road approximately 6 feet to the west is hereby approved.

This approval applies only to the Partial D&M Plan II revision in the correspondence dated December 5, 2024.

Please be advised that deviations from the Council's Decision and Order and D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-62.

Pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62(b)(2) and the project's Development & Management Plan (D&M) approved July 20, 2023, The United Illuminating Company ("UI") is hereby notifying the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") of a deviation. The deviation that will occur is the shift of the construction entrance off Hawkins Drive approximately 6-feet to the west.

In order to prevent damage/removal of the property owners Willow Tree, UI and the contractor requests to shift the construction entrance for STR 11, off Hawkins Road, approximately 6-feet to the west. The shift of the construction entrance will remain within UI's current approved easement. The construction of the entrance will be consistent with the D&M Plan. The landowner has been contacted and has provided his acceptance of the revised location.
